Format: **K3, K6, & K12** div. Five round Swiss G30. WSCF membership not required.
USCF **K12** 4 round Swiss G45. USCF membership required. USCF membership ID required for entry in this division. USCF memberships purchase on site available.

Awards: **K3:** 5 team trophies, individual trophies to top 5 players and medals to all.
K6: 5 team trophies, individual trophies to top 5 players and medals to all.
K12: 3 team trophies, individual trophies to top 5 players and medals to all.
K12 USCF: 1 team trophies, individual trophies to top 3 players and medals to all.

This tournament is a **Club Team** tournament. Award Ceremony around 4:00 pm.

One year Family Memberships will be awarded to the Champion of each Division.

Entry: Register on line at www.wisconsinscholasticchess.org **\$15** entry fee by 11:00 pm Jan 8; **\$20** by 11:00 pm Jan 15; **\$25** by 11:00 pm on Jan 19. Onsite registration **\$40**. **Onsite registration for Round 1 closes at 8:30.**

Check in to get your wrist bands will be open from 8:00 to 8:45 for round 1 and from 8:45 to 9:30 for round 2. Access to the exhibits will be open at 8:30. Other exhibits will open at the normal time of 10:00 am and all will be open till close at 5:00 pm.
