Location: Bay Shore Town Center 5800 N. Bay Shore Drive Glendale, WI 53217
Tournament play in food court or *IPIC* Rotunda

Format: A series of six tournaments on six Saturdays. USCF Rated. Two Divisions U1200 and Open. Club and School Teams may participate. 4 Round Swiss each Saturday. Top 4 scores for each tournament for individuals and teams will be used for determining awards.
G45, G45, G60, G60 **Times:** Rnd 1- 9:30, 2- 11:15, 3 – 1:30, 4 – 3:45

Eligibility: Students in Kindergarten through 12th grade are eligible to enter

Awards: \$5 Gift Certificate from Board Game Barrister for winner of each division, each Saturday.

A **Grand Prix** is a series of tournaments where the awards are given out after all the events are over. In this Grand Prix only the top four scores from the six events will be used to determine the winners of all six events. If you attend all six events then your four best scores for individual and team scores will be used in the calculations. If you attend four events then your four scores will be used and you can remain competitive for the entire Grand Prix. Another way to say it is that you need attend only four of the events and still win.

In the **U1200 division** a **\$250** scholarship will be given to the Champion of the complete series as determined by the top four scores of the six events. Trophies to top three individuals and top three teams. Will be determined in the same way as well. All participants will receive medals at the sixth event. If you are not at the sixth event winner will need to make arrangement to pick the trophy. In the **OPEN** division the same procedure and awards will apply. Award Ceremony will be around 6 pm on March 27th.

“Club” Teams can be formed from existing clubs and can have students on the team that attend different schools. The clubs must have met at least 4 times and can not be put together solely for this series of tournaments. Any club that has been meeting regularly and has scholastic members are eligible to have a team. School Teams will be comprised of teams members from school of attendance as in past tournaments. Club teams will only be allowed for this Grand Prix event. October Supplement will be used for ratings for all six events. Contestants starting in U1200 Division will remain eligible to play in that division but points would not carry over to the open division.

Entry: \$10 per player for advance registration, \$15 on site registration Check-in from 8:30 to 9:15 am. Please check as early as possible. For advance registration, register online at www.wisconsinscholasticchess.org before 11:00 pm on Thursday before each tournament, registration fee will be paid at the tournament. Make checks payable to **WSCF**.
