Scholastic Chess Tournament



Friday, Saturday, Sunday Nov 20 - 22, 2009

Location: Exposition Center State Fair Grounds 84th and Greenfield, West Allis

Schedule:

Friday: *Education Day* WSCF will have a chess station in the game area and will offer chess lessons, pick up games and simuls at 4:00 and 7:00 against WSCF volunteers.

Saturday: *Chess Tournament* WSCF will offer a 5 round Swiss G30 tournament with two divisions, *K – 6 and Open* Wisconsin Rated. Medals to all. Trophies to top 5 individuals and to top 3 teams in each division.

Registration: Register on line at www.wisconsinscholasticchess.org by 11:00 pm on Thursday Nov 19. Register on site between 10 and 10:30 with Round 1 beginning at 11:00 am. Rounds will commence every 65 minutes and award ceremony will be around 5:00 pm. Registration fee will be \$5 for advance online registration and \$6.00 on site registration.

Sunday: Games on the giant chess boards, Simuls at 11:00 and 2:00 by WSCF volunteers. Chess Lessons and Game Analysis all day.

Each day anyone can play chess for free on the giant chess board, on a tournament board or play WSCF volunteers and participate in simuls with WSCF volunteers at no cost. Simul times will be posted at the event. There will also be group lessons each day and again times will be posted.
