

Holiday Folk Fair

Location: **Exposition Center at Wisconsin State Fair Park**

640 South 84th Street West Allis, WI 53214

Format: **K3, K6 & K12** Five round Swiss G30. WSCF membership not required.

Awards: **K3: Individual trophies to top 5 players, 2 Team trophies and medals to all**
K6: Individual trophies to top 5 players, 2 Team trophies and medals to all.
K12: Individual trophies to top 5 players, 2 Team trophies and medals to all.
Award Ceremony around 4:30 pm if not before.

Entry: **\$10 per player for advance registration, \$15 on-site registration.**

Check-in from 10:00 – 10:30 Round 1 begins close to 11:00. Onsite registration for round 1 ends at 10:30 Pre-registrants arriving after 10:45 and on site registrations arriving after 10:45 can enter the tournament round 2 with a ½ point first round bye. Please check in as early as possible. For advance registration, register online at www.wisconsinscholasticchess.org before midnight on WEDNESDAY on Nov 14th. Registration fee will be paid at the tournament.

Exposition Entry and Folk Fair passes:

All those registering for the tournament in advance by WEDNESDAY will receive free passes into the exposition center. Each participant can have a pass for one chaperone. There is no discount for \$5 parking. Please enter the exposition center on the west side (84th street) and proceed to the volunteer desk. If you preregistered your name will be on the list. If you are not pre-registered you will need to pay for entry into the folk fair. After receiving your entry tickets proceed to the chess tournament area and register for the tournament. You may be able to get your entry tickets slightly before 10:00 but cannot enter until 10:00. The adult registering the student on line will be the person receiving the pass. Coaches please have parents register on line if the parents want the passes into the folk fair. Volunteers for the tournament can also receive a free pass into the Folk Fair.
