- Location:** Steinhafels Furniture, I – 94 and County F, W231 N1013 Redford Blvd Waukesha WI 53186
MapQuest is not reliable for this location. From I – 94 get off at exit 295, go south on County F (Redford Blvd) and take the first right turn in the Steinhafels complex. Take another right to go to the front entrance.
- Format:** Swiss Style, Game 5, Two Divisions: K – 6 and K – 12,
- Rules:** Go to http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Bughouse_chess#Rules to learn more about the games and the rules that will be followed. The variant where the King can be captured and where pieces cannot be dropped into a checking or mating position will be used.
- Awards:** Trophies to top three team winners in each division. Medals to all.
12 Trophies will be awarded
- Entry:** \$10 per player for advance registration on line by Jan 13 (noon) , \$15 on site.
Partners can be declared at registration.
- Check-in:** Check In, pay and register between **5:30 and 6:15**. Play to begin as close to **6:30** as possible. Number of rounds will be determined by number possible to be completed by **8:30 pm**. Awards and clean up at 8:30.
Exit at **9:00** Late entrants welcome. **Register as individuals. You can declare your partner when you check in on site.**
