Entry: \$10 per player for advance registration on line by 11 pm on Nov 17th. \$15 onsite registration.

Registration: Museum opens at 9:00 am. Registration opens from 9:00 to 9:30. Round 1 to begin at 9:45. Those arriving after 9:30 can register for round two. Chess control opens at 9:00am. Museum opens at 9:00am.
