Grade Level Championships



When: Saturday March 10th, 2018 Check in from 7:45 to 8:30 am. Round 1 to begin between 9:15 and 9:30. Awards ceremony after fifth round between 3:00 and 4:30.

Where: St. Luke United Methodist Church 623 Ontario Avenue Sheboygan, WI

Tournament: 5 Round Swiss, G30/d5 10 Divisions, Grades K, 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8, HS (9-12) No Grades will be combined for this tournament. No ½ point byes for this tournament. Students can play only in their grade of attendance at school.

- **If 1 player in a grade**, then that player will receive the championship trophy and play byes from other divisions in each round.
- **If 2 players** then each the players will play twice or 4 times, twice white, and twice black. If Tied after 2 rounds, the 3rd round, etc. until there is a winner.
- **If 3 players** then the three players will play the other players twice, once white, and once black for a total of six rounds.
- **If 4 players**, then the players will play round robin style and if any ties after 3 rounds ties will be broken with games in the 4 and 5th rounds and a 6-round if needed.
- **If 5 players** same format but with 4 rounds, ties broken in rounds 5 and 6.
- **If 6 players** then a normal 5 round robin tournament. Ties broken by computer tie breaks.
- With number of players 2 through 6 players from the same team will play each other

Round Times: 1: 9:15 2: 10:45 3: 12:00 4: 1:15 5: 2:30 Awards: 3:45 or 4:00

Eligibility: This tournament is open to all students in Wisconsin.

Awards: K through 8th Grade - Five individual trophies and one team trophy per grade. A team trophy will be awarded provided there are at least two teams in that division. There will be no team trophy in the kindergarten division. Medals to all. K12 division will have 3 individual trophies.

High School Joint division with individual trophies to top 2 players in each grade. No team trophies.

Teams: Teams are composed of least two students from each school and a max of 3.

Registration: \$12 with registration in advance by 11:00 pm on March 8th. \$17 on site registration.
