Format: K-3, K-6, K-12 divisions. Six round Swiss, G30
USCF K-12 division – Four round Swiss, G45

Awards: **K-3 Division:** 5 team trophies, individual trophies to top 5 players, medals to all others.
K-6 Division: 5 team trophies, individual trophies to top 5 players, medals to all others.
K-12 Division: 3 team trophies, individual trophies to top 5 players, medals to all others.
USCF K-12: 1 team trophy, and 3 individual trophies.

Award ceremony begins around 4:00 p.m.

Entry: \$10 per player for advance registration, \$15 on-site registration

Check-in from 8:00a.m. to 8:30a.m. Round 1 begins close to 9:00a.m. On-site registration for round 1 will end at 8:40a.m. Preregistrants arriving after 8:40a.m. and on-site registrants arriving after 8:30a.m. can enter the tournament round 2. Please check in as early as possible. For advance registration, visit www.wisconsinscholasticchess.org before 11:00p.m. March 1st. The registration fee will be paid at the tournament. **Make checks payable to: Richards School PTO.**

Lunch: Available for purchase on-site.

Chess Notation: Encouraged for students 3rd grade and older.

Bring: Pencils, chess sets and clocks if you have them.

Supervision: At least one designated adult supervisor must be present at all times during the tournament to oversee your school's team or individual participants who are in Kindergarten through 8th grade.
