Format: **K5, K12 &USCF Scholastic- Adult combined** divisions. Five or six round Swiss G30 for K5 and K12. Four round Swiss for USCF division. G45, USCF membership required for USCF division. One time entry fee for USCF division is \$12. \$10 of which can be applied to USCF membership.

Awards: **K5: 2 team trophies, individual trophies to top 3 players and medals to all**
K12: 2 team trophies, individual trophies to top 3 players and medals to all.
USCF: 3 individual trophies to scholastic players, Trophy to top Adult/Student pair.

Teams at this tournament can be made up of club members and not be limited to school of attendance. Clubs are defined as those that were in existence before October 1st and cannot be formed for the purpose of entering this tournament. Award Ceremony around 3:45 pm if not before.

Entry: **\$10 per player for advance registration, \$15 on-site registration.**

Check-in from 8:00 to 8:30. Round 1 begins close to 9:00. Onsite registration for round 1 ends at 8:15.

Pre-registrants arriving after 8:40 and on site registrations arriving after 8:30 can enter the tournament round 2.

No byes. Please check in as early as possible. For advance registration, register online at www.wisconsinscholasticchess.org before 11 pm on Dec 11th. Registration fee will be paid at the tournament.

Food: Available for purchase on site.

Supervision: At least one designated adult supervisor must be present at all times during the tournament to oversee your school's team, or individual participants who are in K through 8th grade.

Bring: Pencils, and clocks if you have them. Chess sets, T-shirts, chess books and other chess items will be available for purchase on site.
