## Chess Tournament

**December 2, 2017**

**Location:** Washington High School 2525 N. Sherman Blvd 53210

**Format:** **K3 K6, and K12 WSCF rated divisions.** Five or six round Swiss G30, or G25, d5.  
**Open USCF rated Division G45, d5 4 rounds**

**Awards:** **K3:** 3 team trophies, individual trophies to top 5 players and medals to all  
**K6:** 3 team trophies, individual trophies to top 5 players and medals to all  
**K12:** 3 team trophies, individual trophies to top 5 players and medals to all  
**Open** A trophy each to each pair with the highest combined point total  
in these combinations: Father – Daughter, Father – Son, Mother – Son, Mother –  
Daughter, Coach – Student, and Friend – student.  
Open division is open to adults and students. Adult partner for awards plays in the open and  
student partner plays in the scholastic.

Award Ceremony around 3:30 pm if not before.

**Entry:** **WSCF Scholastic Divisions:** \$10 per player for advance registration on line and payment at  
the tournament. \$15 on-site registration  
**Open Division:** Registration and payment on line. \$20 in advance. \$25 on site.

Check-in from 8:00 to 8:40. Round 1 begins close to 9:00. Those arriving after 8:40 can register for Round 2.
