



# WSCF Spring Break Chess Camps



WSCF instructors will lead chess camps over spring break. Each camp will be 3 hours per day for 5 days, taking place March 27th-31st. Morning (beginner) and afternoon (intermediate) sessions available.

These camps are for those new to chess or those that are experienced and want to improve their chess skills. Students will focus on chess fundamentals including opening strategy, the 7 basic checkmates, and tactics such as Forks, Pins and Discovered Check. Students will experience a balance of chess play and instruction. They will compete in a 5-round tournament with the top 3 winning trophies and everyone else receiving a medal. Each student will also receive a free Gold Membership to Chesskid.com. The intermediate camp will cover all phases of the game including chess notation and game analysis. Those that have played two to three years are recommended to take the Intermediate camp.
