Awards: **K5U500:** Two team trophies, individual trophies to top 7 players and medals to all.

U800: Two team trophies, individual trophies to top 7 players and medals to all.

WSCF Open: Two team trophies, individual trophies to top 7 players and medals to all.

*The **winner of the open division** will also receive a box set of 6 books by Yasser Seirawan: Endings, Strategies, Openings, Play Winning Chess, Tactics, and Brilliances.*

Friends and Family: This division is for adults who want to play. Participants have the option of pairing with a student (friend, club member, son, daughter). A trophy will go to the top three students of the pair with the highest combined scores. Adults will register singly on the website.
