Maryland Avenue Montessori Chess Tournament

Saturday, February 7, 2026

Location: Maryland Avenue Montessori – Gym & Adolescent Wing (Southern section of building)
2418 N. Maryland Ave, Milwaukee, WI 53224

Parking: Entrance, parking lot, & street parking are located on Prospect Avenue (not Maryland).

Format: Four Divisions: K5u500, K8u600, and K8u800 and Open. Five round Swiss, Game 30.

Awards: Three team trophies and five individual trophies per division. Medals to all competitors.

Awards at or around 4:00 p.m. Note that a team needs at least three players to win a trophy, and the above four divisions are guidelines and may be adjusted once registration is complete. The goal is to create fair and balanced divisions.

Check-in from 8:00 to 8:45 a.m. Round 1 begins between 9:15 to 9:30 a.m. Onsite registration for Round 1 ends at 8:30 a.m. Pre-registrants arriving after 8:45 a.m. and onsite registrants arriving after 8:30 a.m. can enter the tournament in Round 2. *Please check-in as early as possible.*

Entry Fee: \$20 per player for advance registration, \$25 on-site registration.

Supervision: At least one designated adult supervisor is always required to chaperone Chess Teams and individual competitors in kindergarten through 8th grade.
