National Chess Day Tournament at Old Guard Games

Saturday, October 10, 2026

Location: Old Guard Games (3132 N Downer Ave. Milwaukee, WI 53211)

Format: Two Divisions: K5U500 and Open. Five round Swiss style, Game 30.

Awards: One team trophy and individual trophies to top 5 players per division. Medals to all.

Awards at approximately 4:00 p.m. or earlier. Note that a team needs at least three players to win a trophy, and division parameters may be changed depending upon the number, age, and ratings of registrants.

Check-in from 8:00 to 8:45 a.m. Round 1 begins between 9:15 to 9:30 a.m. Onsite registration for Round 1 ends at 8:30 a.m. Pre-registrants arriving after 8:45 a.m. and onsite registrants arriving after 8:30 a.m. can enter the tournament in Round 2. Please check-in as early as possible.

For advance registration, visit www.wisconsinscholasticchess.org before 11:00 p.m. on the Thursday prior to the tournament.

Entry Fee: \$25 per player for advance registration, \$30 on-site registration.

Concessions: Available at Valentine Coffee (located in front of playing room)

Supervision: At least one designated adult supervisor is always required to chaperone Chess Teams and individual competitors in kindergarten through 8th grade.
